**Getting to know you
(Christmas in France)**

Key Question: How can I communicate in French?

National Curriculum Objectives:

- ♣ understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources
- ♣ speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say, including through discussion and asking questions, and continually improving the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation
- ♣ can write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt
- ♣ discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in the language studied.

Prior Learning:

Introduce French through KS1 using range of resources such as songs and books during story times.
Daily opportunities to speak through register.

End Point:

Can have simple conversations with a partner and can complete conversational sentence stems.
Know how to say and write numbers to 10
Take part in a French Nursery rhyme
Know how Christmas is celebrated in France

Progression Language and Grammar development:

- Responding to a greeting
- Take part in a simple conversation
- Following simple instructions
- Participate in a simple rhyme and a play
- Numbers 1- 10
- Ask someone for their age and know how to respond

Everyday French:

- Greetings
- Numbers 1-10
- Age
- French cultural traditions

Cross-Curricular Links

Geography- Use globe, atlas, maps and Google Earth to look at the countries that speak French and the different dialects (France, Caribbean, Canada, North Africa)

Are these countries close to one another? Why do they speak French?

English- Writing Christmas cards

Maths- Create maths activities/ games using the numbers the children have learnt.

Music- Listening to French Christmas Carols and singing rhymes and songs

Children to look at the lyrics of both songs and compare

Can the children recognise any of the songs? Is there an English version of the song?

RE- Religious festivals and learning about Christmas in France
